WIFV member **Jay Mallin**'s new documentary, THE THREE (KNOWN) LYNCHINGS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MARYLAND, has been getting some local press, with stories on WTOP and a segment



on WAMU's *Kojo Nnamdi Show* on December 1. You can hear that interview here.

The doc details the stories of three lynchings that took place in the county in the late 1800s. Although extensively covered by national press at the time, they were forgotten — or erased — from county history until very recently. All three acts of nighttime racial terrorism left the body of a young African American man hanging by a major county road until morning, and in none of the three cases was there a real effort to prosecute any of the lynchers. In one part of the film narrator Michael V. Williams, an award-winning county public school teacher, speaks from experience on the impact on African American communities in the county today. The film premiered in November in a soldout event sponsored by the Montgomery County Lynching Memorial Project, and was made possible by a grant from the Arts & Humanities Council of Montgomery County.

Control, a dramatic short form series created and filmed remotely during lockdown by a global team of collaborators and produced by WIFV member **Mikail Chowdury** and Sana Soni.

More recently Brindamour wrote scores and the title theme for *Becoming America*. This anthology series is set in three different parts of the country (Los Angeles, Chicago, and Durham) and the three stories highlight under-represented populations and explore our differences while discovering the surprising bonds that bind us together.
