The Image Makers program is a community outreach program of Women in Film & Video. Our mission is to introduce local youth to television and video production through creation and development of a broadcast ready public service announcements (PSAs) to benefit area non-profit organizations. On last day of program we recognize the achievements of the participating youth by holding a public screening and awards ceremony that usually takes place first or second week of April.

Women in Film & Video members, local production professionals, and area businesses volunteer their time and resources to guide metropolitan Washington, DC youth through the development of videos for non-profit organizations. They help youth learn more about the script-to-screen production process and explore the types of jobs available in the industry. -Students will also discover how to craft a powerful and persuasive message, and to more critically evaluate the messages they see in the media.

Workshop Leaders act as instructors for the students and guide them through the production process. Actual film/video production exposure is required (at least know what generally goes into the stages of a project: pre-production, production, and post-production). Sessions run 8 weeks (Saturdays 9:30am-1:30pm) with extended hours on actual shoot and edit day(s) typically scheduled late March. Program participants are divided into groups to include one to three Workshop Leaders. Volunteers are provided a maximum of two leaves of absence days; therefore, please inform your workshop leader with advance notice to ensure coverage.
