The Image Makers program is a community outreach program of Women in Film & Video. Our mission is to introduce local youth to television and video production through creation of public service announcements (PSAs) that benefit area non-profit organizations. We also recognize the achievements of the participating youth by sponsoring a public screening and awards ceremony.

Women in Film & Video members, local production professionals, and area businesses volunteer their time and resources to guide metropolitan Washington, DC youth through the development of videos for non-profit organizations. They help youth learn more about the script-to-screen production process and explore the types of jobs available in the industry. The students also discover how to make their message powerful and persuasive, and how to look more critically at the messages they see in the media.

Workshop Leaders act as instructors for the students and guide them through the production process. Actual film/video production exposure is required (at least know what generally goes into the stages of a project: pre-production, production, and post-production).

Sessions run 8 weeks (Saturdays 9:30 am–1:30 pm) beginning in February. We will have one physical meeting prior to the program launch and 2-3 update calls during the program.

Our goal is to have at least three Workshop Leaders and two Production Coordinators per group. You will not be required to attend every session. Each team will be required to work with team members to ensure coverage.
