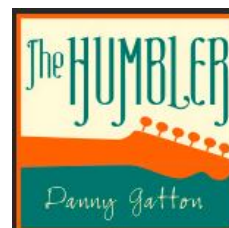

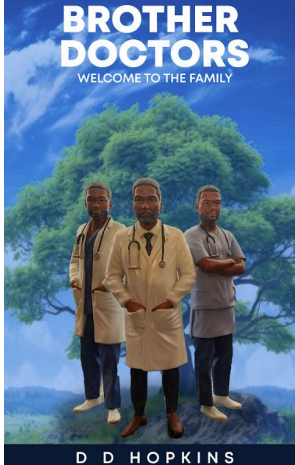

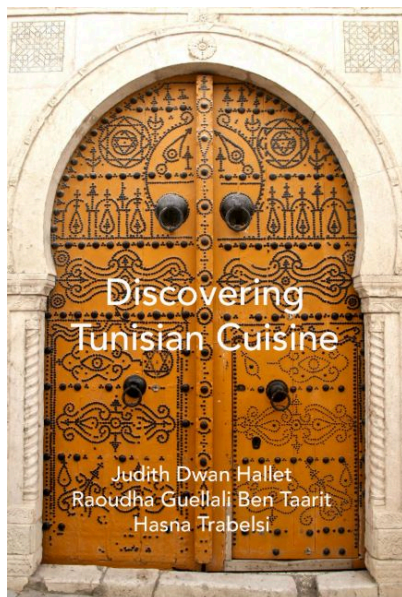
Fitzpatrick Announces Pre-Sale for *Destination Stewardship*

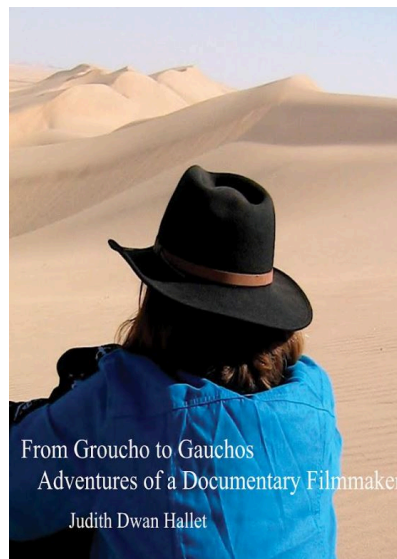

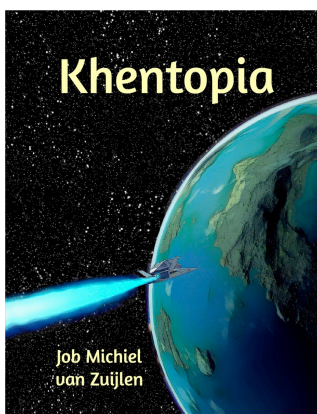

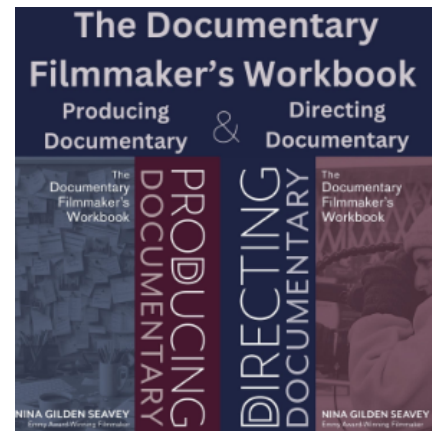
